

Treatment Package

LASIK Laser-Assisted In Situ Keratomileusis



Involves creating a corneal flap, reshaping the underlying tissue with a laser, and then repositioning the flap. Known for quick recovery and minimal discomfort, it is effective for treating farsightedness, nearsightedness, and astigmatism.

SMILE

Small Incision Lenticule Extraction



A minimally invasive procedure where a laser is used to create a small, disc-shaped piece of tissue within the cornea, which is then removed through a small incision. SMILE is valued for its potential in reducing dry eye symptoms.

ASA or ASA (Advance surface ablation) or TransPRK (Transepithelial Photorefractive Keratectomy)



A surface-based procedure that involves removing the outer layer of the cornea (epithelium) before reshaping the underlying tissue with a laser. ASA/ TransPRK is suitable for those with thin corneas and may be associated with a longer initial recovery compared to LASIK.



Implantable Collamer Lens may also be considered. Especially those who are deemed not suitable for LASIK procedure this will be discussed with your doctor.

Pre-LASIK Assessment

Please stop wearing contact lens completely, before your pre-LASIK assessment:

- a. Soft Lens (1-2 weeks)
- b. Semi Hard/Rigid Gas Permeable Lens (3-4 weeks)

For your pre-LASIK assessment, your eyes may be dilated for a full examination and you will experience blurriness for a period of 3 to 4 hours. Therefore, please arrange for someone to drive you home after pre-LASIK assessment.



Please bring your eyeglasses on the day of consultation. Approximately 3 to 4 hours in clinic. Please take this into consideration when you make plan for the day.

Pre-op instructions

- Please lay off contact lens completely for 1 week before the surgery
- Both eyes are usually done on the same day
- · No fasting required

Before surgery

- · Do not wear contact lens
- Shower & wash your hair
- Strictly NO make-up (especially eye make-up, mascara, eyelash extension) & perfume
- Bring a jacket or a sweater to keep you warm as the surgery room is cold
- Arrange your transportation after the sur
- Follow-up consultation: 1 day, 1 week, 1 month - separate charges apply



4 During surgery

- Do not squeeze your eyes tightly or move your head
- Do not move your eyes suddenly
- Do not be afraid of the laser sound
- Some burnt odor during the LASIK procedure is expected and is not a cause for concern



5 After surgery

- Wash your hands before caring for the eye
- Instill eye drops as instructed do not squeeze your eyes upon instillation
- Clean the eyes and face area gently
- DO NOT RUB THE EYE
- Wear a sun visor/sunglasses during outdoor activities
- Wear protective goggles when cooking
- Wash your hair without splashing water into your eyes for at least a week, if not possible, wash your hair in a hair saloon
- Watching TV and working with computer is allowed but please do not strain your eyes
- No eye make-up for one (1) month
- No swimming and water activities for a month
- Avoid smoky or dusty areas, e.g. discotheque, pub, gardening etc
- Please take all precautions to avoid pregnancy: 6 weeks BEFORE and AFTER the refractive surgery
